INTRODUCTION:

The objective of the training program is to provide theoretical and practical knowledge and necessary skills for students to become experts in the field of economic law, specializing in international business; have the ability to work independently or as a leader at State agencies, economic organizations, enterprises, research and training institutions, judicial agencies and law-making agencies.

TRAINING ORGANIZATIONS:

1. Training duration: 18 months (in the evenings and/or on weekends)
2. Teaching language: Vietnamese
3. Fee: 58.000.000 VND/year (adjusted annually by the regulations of Foreign Trade University)
